House Bill 3018

Sponsored by Representative C EDWARDS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Allows Oregon Commission on Autism Spectrum Disorder created by executive order of Governor to accept contributions of moneys from any source. Creates Oregon Commission on Autism Spectrum Disorder Fund to receive contributions. Continuously appropriates moneys in fund to commission for purposes of carrying out duties of commission.

Specifies that amounts remaining in fund on January 1, 2011, are transferred to General Fund.

Sunsets January 2, 2011.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Commission on Autism Spectrum Disorder created by Exec-
6	utive Order 09 of the Governor may accept contributions of moneys and assistance
7	from the United States Government or its agencies or from any other source, public or pri-
8	vate, and agree to conditions placed on the moneys not inconsistent with the duties of the
9	commission.
10	(2) The Oregon Commission on Autism Spectrum Disorder Fund is established in the
11	State Treasury, separate and distinct from the General Fund. Interest earned by the Oregon
12	Commission on Autism Spectrum Disorder Fund shall be credited to the fund.
13	(3) All moneys received by the Oregon Commission on Autism Spectrum Disorder under
14	this section shall be paid into the Oregon Commission on Autism Spectrum Disorder Fund.
15	Moneys in the Oregon Commission on Autism Spectrum Disorder Fund are continuously
16	appropriated to the commission for the purposes of carrying out the duties of the commis-
17	sion.
18	(4) Any moneys remaining in the Oregon Commission on Autism Spectrum Disorder Fund
19	on January 1, 2011, are transferred to the General Fund.
20	(5) This section is repealed January 2, 2011.
21	SECTION 2. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
22	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect
23	on its passage.
