SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Grants recipient of unemployment insurance benefits \$25 weekly allowance for each dependent child living in household.

Directs Director of Employment Department to adopt rules implementing allowance.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

2	Relating to unemployment insurance benefits; and prescribing an effective date.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2009 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 657.
5	SECTION 2. (1) In addition to benefits computed under ORS 657.150, a person eligible for
6	benefits under ORS 657.155 is entitled to an allowance of \$25 per week for each dependent
7	child living in the person's household during that week.
8	(2) The Director of the Employment Department shall adopt rules to implement the de-
9	pendent child allowance permitted under subsection (1) of this section.
10	SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2009 Act applies to applications for benefits submitted on
11	or after July 1, 2010.
12	SECTION 4. This 2009 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the reg-
13	ular session of the Seventy-fifth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
