

House Bill 3045

Sponsored by Representative SHIELDS; Representatives BARKER, C EDWARDS, GARRARD, GELSER, GREENLICK, HARKER, KAHL, READ, RILEY, STIEGLER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Grants recipient of unemployment insurance benefits \$25 weekly allowance for each dependent child living in household.

Directs Director of Employment Department to adopt rules implementing allowance.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to unemployment insurance benefits; and prescribing an effective date.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2009 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 657.**

5 **SECTION 2. (1) In addition to benefits computed under ORS 657.150, a person eligible for**
6 **benefits under ORS 657.155 is entitled to an allowance of \$25 per week for each dependent**
7 **child living in the person's household during that week.**

8 **(2) The Director of the Employment Department shall adopt rules to implement the de-**
9 **pendent child allowance permitted under subsection (1) of this section.**

10 **SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2009 Act applies to applications for benefits submitted on**
11 **or after July 1, 2010.**

12 **SECTION 4. This 2009 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the reg-**
13 **ular session of the Seventy-fifth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
