

# House Bill 3047

Sponsored by Representatives KAHL, MATTHEWS, J SMITH; Representative SCHAUFLER, Senators MONNES ANDERSON, MONROE

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District of Oregon to implement pilot project using volunteer greeters on light rail system vehicles to improve user safety and decrease fare evasion and criminal activity.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District of Oregon shall es-**  
5 **tablish a pilot project using volunteer greeters on light rail system vehicles for the purposes**  
6 **of:**

7 (a) **Improving the safety of system users; and**

8 (b) **Decreasing the incidence of fare evasion and criminal activity.**

9 (2) **To the extent practicable, the district shall prefer the use of volunteer greeters with**  
10 **law enforcement experience.**
