## **3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 475.340 is amended to read:

5 475.340. Nothing in ORS 475.300 to 475.346 shall be construed to [require]:

6 (1) **Require** a government medical assistance program or private health insurer to reimburse a

7 person for costs associated with the medical use of marijuana[; or].

8 (2) **Require** an employer to:

9 (a) Accommodate the medical use of marijuana in any workplace regardless of where the use
10 occurs;

(b) Allow an employee or independent contractor to possess, to consume or to be im paired by the use of marijuana during working hours; or

13 (c) Allow any person who is impaired by the use of marijuana to remain in the workplace.

14 (3) Preclude or restrict an employer from establishing or enforcing a policy to achieve

15 or maintain a drug-free workforce.
