House Bill 3075

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON AGRICULTURE, NATURAL RESOURCES AND RURAL COMMUNITIES

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Prohibits Legislative Administration Committee from placing time restrictions on use of State Capitol steps for speech purposes.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to the State Capitol; amending ORS 276.002; and declaring an emergency. 2

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3

SECTION 1. ORS 276.002 is amended to read: 4

276.002. (1) The Legislative Assembly, through the Legislative Administration Committee, shall 5 exercise control over the use of the State Capitol. 6

7 (2) The committee has exclusive power to assign and reassign quarters in the State Capitol for 8 such periods and under such terms, including rental rates, as the committee considers appropriate.

(3) All rentals for quarters and for parking shall be credited to the State Capitol Operating 9 Account. 10

(4) The committee has exclusive power to assign and reassign parking spaces in the garage of 11 12 the State Capitol, in the area immediately north of the State Capitol but south of and separated from Court Street by a traffic island, painted markings or other traffic control devices and in the area 1314 immediately south of the State Capitol but north of and separated from State Street by a traffic island, painted markings or other traffic control devices. The committee has exclusive power to pre-15 16 scribe parking regulations in the garage and the other areas described in this subsection and may 17prescribe fines or other penalties for violating those regulations. The committee shall give notice of any parking prohibitions or restrictions by posting appropriate signs in plain view. The Depart-18 19 ment of State Police shall enforce the regulations described in this subsection. All citations issued 20 for violating the parking regulations described in this subsection shall conform to the requirements 21of ORS 810.425. Notwithstanding other provisions of this subsection, the Oregon Department of Ad-22ministrative Services is responsible for collecting parking fees under ORS 292.065.

23(5) The committee may enter into contracts or agreements the committee considers necessary 24 to:

(a) Renovate and repair the State Capitol;

26 (b) Renovate, repair or replace State Capitol fixtures and facilities;

(c) Make artistic or aesthetic improvements to the State Capitol and adjacent areas; 27

28 (d) Conduct or sponsor special events; and

29 (e) Conduct or sponsor projects intended to preserve or promote the historical integrity of the 30 State Capitol and adjacent areas.

31 (6) The committee may not restrict the hours during which the exterior State Capitol
