House Bill 3088

Sponsored by Representative SCHAUFLER (at the request of Jan Esler-Rowe)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Exempts small nonresidential uses from certain system development charges for minor increases in impacts.

2	Relating to system development charges.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2009 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 223.297 to
5	223.314.
6	SECTION 2. (1) A local government may not assess a system development charge for
7	transportation, drainage or parks on an existing nonresidential use that is increasing its
8	impacts upon transportation, drainage or parks by less than 25 percent if:
9	(a) The nonresidential use occupies a building or buildings totaling less than 10,000 square
10	feet in size; or
11	(b) The nonresidential use generates an average of fewer than 200 daily trips each
12	weekday.
13	(2) If the increase of a nonresidential use described in subsection (1)(a) or (b) of this
14	section results in impacts upon transportation, drainage or parks greater than 25 percent,
15	the local government may assess system development charges for the impacts that are above
16	25 percent.
