SUMMARY

Changes sunset date on conditional exemption from disclosure of public records that set forth name, home address or professional location of person engaged in, or providing goods and services for, medical research at Oregon Health and Science University that is conducted on animals other than rodents.

5 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

6 **SECTION 1.** Section 4, chapter 455, Oregon Laws 2005, is amended to read:

7 **Sec. 4.** The amendments to ORS 192.501 by section 3 [*of this 2005 Act*], **chapter 455, Oregon**
8 **Laws 2005**, become operative on January 2, [2010] **2012**.
