SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Allows applicant for certification as emergency medical technician or first responder to substitute certification by National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians for completion of training course approved by Department of Human Services.]

Directs Department of Human Services to adopt rules to allow emergency medical technician applicant to substitute experience and certification by national registry of emergency medical technicians for certain requirements imposed by department.

Relating to emergency medical personnel.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The Department of Human Services shall adopt rules to allow an applicant for certification by indorsement as an emergency medical technician, as defined in ORS 682.025, to substitute experience and certification by a national registry of emergency medical technicians for education requirements imposed by the department.
