Requires public institutions of higher education to interview qualified minority candidate when hiring head [football] coach or athletic director unless institution is bound by contract to promote member of current coaching staff.

## Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 4

 $\mathbf{5}$ SECTION 1. ORS 352.380 is amended to read:

352.380. Each institution under the jurisdiction of the State Board of Higher Education shall: 6

(1) Consider and maintain affirmative action plans and goals when reductions in faculty and 7

staff are required as a result of: 8

[(1)] (a) Reductions in revenue that necessitate discontinuance of its educational program at its 9 10 anticipated level;

11 [(2)] (b) Elimination of classes due to decreased student enrollment; or

[(3)] (c) Reduction in courses due to administrative decisions. 12

(2) Interview one or more qualified minority applicants when hiring a head coach or 13 athletic director, unless the institution is bound by contract to promote a member of the 14 institution's current coaching staff. 15

SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 352.380 by section 1 of this 2009 Act first apply to 16 head coach or athletic director positions that open on or after the effective date of this 2009 17 Act. 18

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
