House Bill 3118

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires public institutions of higher education to interview minority candidate when hiring head football coach unless institution is bound by contract to promote member of current coaching staff.

4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. ORS 352.380 is amended to read:
6	352.380. Each institution under the jurisdiction of the State Board of Higher Education shall:
7	(1) Consider and maintain affirmative action plans and goals when reductions in faculty and
8	staff are required as a result of:
9	[(1)] (a) Reductions in revenue that necessitate discontinuance of its educational program at its
10	anticipated level;
11	[(2)] (b) Elimination of classes due to decreased student enrollment; or
12	[(3)] (c) Reduction in courses due to administrative decisions.
13	(2) Interview one or more minority applicants when hiring a head football coach, unless
14	the institution is bound by contract to promote a member of the institution's current
15	coaching staff.
16	SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 352.380 by section 1 of this 2009 Act first apply to
17	head football coach positions that open on or after the effective date of this 2009 Act.
