

House Bill 3124

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires operator of light rail system to provide stickers and lanyards for visible ticketing.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to visible ticketing for light rail systems.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. An operator of a light rail system shall provide the following visible ticketing items that may be worn by passengers to demonstrate the payment of a fare:

(1) Stickers for passengers purchasing a ticket; and

(2) Lanyards for multiple-day passes.

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
