SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Requires utility provider to [make reasonable effort to locate utility transmission and distribution lines in exclusive farm use zones so that lines have least practical impact on farming operations] consult with owners of high-value farmland for purpose of locating and constructing transmission line in manner that minimizes impact on farming operations.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to utility facilities.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 **<u>SECTION 1.</u>** (1) As used in this section:

5 (a) "High-value farmland" has the meaning given that term in ORS 195.300.

6 (b) "Transmission line" means a linear utility facility by which a utility provider trans-

7 fers the utility product in bulk from a point of origin or generation, or between transfer

stations, to the point at which the utility product is transferred to distribution lines for delivery to end users.

10 (2) If the criteria described in ORS 215.275 for siting a utility facility on land zoned for 11 exclusive farm use are met for a utility facility that is a transmission line, the utility pro-12 vider shall, after the route is approved by the siting authorities and before construction of 13 the transmission line begins, consult with the owners of high-value farmland in the planned 14 route for the purpose of locating and constructing the transmission line in a manner that 15 minimizes the impact on farming operations on high-value farmland.
