SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires state agency using inmate labor to report to Legislative Assembly regarding use of inmate labor. Requires agency to post notice of use of inmate labor on agency's website.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 2 Relating to inmate labor. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. (1) If a state agency uses state correctional institution inmate labor for any 4 purpose, the agency shall: 5 6 (a) Post a notice, in a conspicuous location on the agency's Internet website, if any, in-7 dicating that the agency uses inmate labor; and 8 (b) Submit an annual, written report to the Legislative Assembly that includes: 9 (A) A description of any work performed by inmates; (B) An estimate of the number of state employees displaced by the use of inmate labor; 10 (C) A description of the training provided to the inmates; and 11 12 (D) A description of the policies adopted by the agency to protect personally identifiable 13information that may be accessible by inmates performing work for the agency. (2) As used in this section: 14 (a) "Conspicuous location" means in the immediate proximity of the telephone number 15or other contact information of the state agency, if the agency's Internet website includes 16 a telephone number or other contact information. 17 (b) "State agency" means any officer, board, commission, department, division or insti-18 tution in the executive or administrative branch of state government. 19 20
