Requires that any coal used to produce energy in Oregon on and after January 1, 2025, must achieve zero percent emission of greenhouse gases.

1	SECTION 1. On and after January 1, 2025, any coal used to produce energy in Oregon
5	must be used in such a way to achieve a zero percent emission of greenhouse gases, as that
3	term is defined in ORS 468A.210.
7	SECTION 2. The State Department of Energy may adopt rules necessary to implement
3	section 1 of this 2009 Act.
