

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3236

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after the semicolon insert “creating new provisions; and”.

2 Delete lines 4 through 24 and insert:

3 “**SECTION 1.** ORS 689.645 is amended to read:

4 “689.645. (1) In accordance with rules adopted by the State Board of Pharmacy under ORS
5 689.205, a pharmacist may administer[.]

6 “[*(a)*] vaccines [*and immunizations*] to persons who are at least [*18*] **11** years of age[; *and*]

7 “[*(b)*] *Influenza vaccines to persons who are at least 15 years of age*].

8 “(2) The board is authorized to issue, to licensed pharmacists who have completed training ac-
9 credited by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the American Council on Pharmaceu-
10 tical Education or a similar health authority or professional body, certificates of special competency
11 in the administration of vaccines [*and immunizations*] to persons [*more than 15*] **who are at least**
12 **11** years of age.

13 “(3) The board shall adopt rules relating to the reporting of the administration of vaccines [*and*
14 *immunizations*] to a patient’s primary health care provider and to the Department of Human Ser-
15 vices.

16 “(4) The board shall adopt rules requiring pharmacists to establish protocols for the adminis-
17 tration of vaccines [*and immunizations*] to persons who are at least [*18*] **11** years of age [*and for the*
18 *administration of influenza vaccines to persons who are at least 15 years of age*].

19 “(5) The board shall convene a volunteer Immunization and Vaccination Advisory Committee
20 consisting of no more than nine members for the purpose of advising the board in promulgating rules
21 under this section. The committee shall consist of one representative from the Department of Human
22 Services, two representatives from the Oregon Medical Board, two representatives from the Oregon
23 State Board of Nursing and two representatives from the State Board of Pharmacy and no more than
24 two pharmacists other than the representatives from the State Board of Pharmacy.

25 “**SECTION 2.** **The Department of Human Services shall adopt rules requiring pharmacists**
26 **to report information about the administration of vaccines to the immunization registry**
27 **created under ORS 433.094.**

28 “**SECTION 3.** (1) **Section 2 of this 2009 Act and the amendments to ORS 689.645 by section**
29 **1 of this 2009 Act become operative on January 1, 2011.**

30 “(2) **The State Board of Pharmacy may take any action before the operative date speci-**
31 **fied in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the board to exercise, on and**
32 **after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all the duties, functions**
33 **and powers conferred on the board by the amendments to ORS 689.645 by section 1 of this**
34 **2009 Act.**

35 “(3) **The Department of Human Services may take any action before the operative date**

1 **specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the department to ex-**
2 **ercise, on and after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all the du-**
3 **ties, functions and powers conferred on the department by section 2 of this 2009 Act.”.**

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
