## House Bill 3246

Sponsored by Representative HUNT; Representatives C EDWARDS, MAURER

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Gives certain districts extension of exemption from requirements regarding health benefit plans offered by Oregon Educators Benefit Board.

1	A BILL	FOR A	AN	ACT

Relating to extension of time for exemption of certain districts from Oregon Educators Benefit Board requirements; amending section 16, chapter 7, Oregon Laws 2007.

## Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

- **SECTION 1.** Section 16, chapter 7, Oregon Laws 2007, as amended by section 7, chapter 39, Oregon Laws 2008, is amended to read:
- **Sec. 16.** (1) Except as provided in this section, the requirements of ORS 243.886 become operative on October 1, 2008.
- (2) If a collective bargaining agreement exists between a district and a group of employees of the district on July 1, 2007, and the contract does not expire before July 1, 2008, ORS 243.886 does not apply to the group of represented employees until the earlier of:
  - (a) October 1, 2009, if the collective bargaining agreement expires before July 1, 2009; or
  - (b) October 1, 2010, if the collective bargaining agreement expires on or after July 1, 2009.
- (3) A district with represented and nonrepresented employees is not required to offer benefit plans to its nonrepresented employees in the manner provided by ORS 243.886 until the district is required to offer those plans to all or part of the represented employees of the district.
- (4) The requirement of ORS 243.886 (2)(a) that self-insured districts and districts with independent health insurance trusts have premiums for benefits that are equal to or less than the premiums for comparable benefit plans provided and administered by the Oregon Educators Benefit Board, becomes operative on October 1, [2010] 2013.
