

# House Bill 3293

Sponsored by Representative MAURER; Representatives BENTZ, BERGER, BRUUN, CAMERON, GILLIAM, HANNA, HARKER, KENNEMER, OLSON, RICHARDSON, SPRENGER, THATCHER, THOMPSON, WEIDNER

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Consumer and Business Services to adopt rules allowing and encouraging health insurers to use financial incentives or penalties to reinforce positive behaviors and discourage negative behaviors.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to health insurance.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Consumer and Business Services shall adopt rules**  
5 **allowing and encouraging insurers offering health insurance to use financial incentives or**  
6 **penalties to reinforce positive individual health behaviors and discourage negative individual**  
7 **health behaviors.**

8 **(2) The rules adopted by the department under subsection (1) of this section must comply**  
9 **with the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (P.L. 104-91) and federal**  
10 **regulations that are issued in conjunction with the Act.**
