SUMMARY

Allows community colleges and state institutions of higher education to recover from school districts costs of providing remedial education to students.

A BILL FOR AN ACT
Relating to remedial education.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Community colleges and state institutions of higher education may recover from a school district in this state the cost of providing remedial education to a student if the student received a high school diploma from a school in the school district.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2009 Act first applies to the 2010-2011 school year.
