## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 3298

On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, after "reserves;" delete the rest of the line and

3	Delete lines 4 through 25 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:
4	"SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, 'Metolius Area of Critical State Concern' means
5	the areas identified as Area 1 and Area 2 in the management plan recommended by the Land
6	Conservation and Development Commission.
7	"(2) Pursuant to ORS 197.405 (4), the Legislative Assembly hereby approves the recom-
8	mendation of the commission, submitted to the Legislative Assembly on April 2, 2009, that
9	the Metolius Area of Critical State Concern be designated an area of critical state concern.
10	"(3) The Legislative Assembly approves the management plan included in the commis-
11	sion's recommendation pursuant to ORS 197.405 (1)(c) and directs the commission to adopt
12	the management plan, by rule, without change except that:
13	"(a) The management plan must require:
14	"(A) The commission to give notice of proposed amendments to the management plan to
15	the governing bodies of Jefferson County and of the Confederated Tribes of the Warm
16	Springs Indian Reservation; and
17	"(B) If either governing body files a written objection to the proposed amendments, the
18	commission to adopt the proposed amendments only if the commission finds by clear and
19	convincing evidence that the proposed amendments meet the requirements of subsection (5)
20	of this section.
21	"(b) The management plan must limit development of a small-scale recreation community
22	within township 13 south, range 10 east, sections 20, 21, 28 and 29 in Jefferson County so that
23	all units must be sited within up to 25 clusters that may be connected only by a road system.
24	The commission may not enforce, and shall modify, a contrary provision in the management
25	plan.
26	"(c) Descriptions in the management plan of annual average water use must refer to

"(5) In addition to limitations on development that are contained in the management plan, new development allowed by amendment of the management plan, except development allowed by the administrative amendments required by subsection (3) of this section, may not result in:

1	"(a) Negative impact on the Metolius River, its springs or its tributaries;
2	"(b) Negative impact on fish resources in the Metolius Area of Critical State Concern;

4	"(c) Negative impact on the wildlife resources in the Metolius Area of Critical State
5	Concern.
6	"(6) A county may not approve siting a destination resort in the Metolius Area of Critical
7	State Concern.
8	"SECTION 2. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
9	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect

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on its passage.".

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
