SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Reserves _____ percent of federal workforce investment funds allocated to state for training activities that support clean technology and prepare workers for employment in green jobs.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to workforce development activity funding; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) Of the federal funds allocated to the state and reserved by the Governor**
5 **for workforce investment activities under 29 U.S.C. 2853, the Governor shall reserve**
6 **_____ percent for training activities that support clean technology and prepare workers for**
7 **employment in green jobs.**

8 **(2) As used in this section, "green job" means a job that provides services or produces**
9 **a product that:**

10 **(a) Increases energy efficiency;**

11 **(b) Produces renewable energy;**

12 **(c) Prevents, reduces or mitigates environmental degradation;**

13 **(d) Cleans up and restores the natural environment; or**

14 **(e) Provides education, consultation, policy promotion, accreditation, trading and offsets**
15 **or similar services supporting the activities specified in this subsection.**

16 **SECTION 2. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
17 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect**
18 **on its passage.**
