

# House Bill 3316

Sponsored by Representative WEIDNER; Representatives BERGER, ESQUIVEL, G SMITH, THATCHER, WHISNANT

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Provides one-time \$400 credit against income taxes for completion of parenting class.  
Applies to tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2010.  
Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to tax credit for parenting class; and prescribing an effective date.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2009 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 315.**

5 **SECTION 2. (1) A credit against the taxes otherwise due under ORS chapter 316 shall be**  
6 **allowed to a taxpayer who during the tax year completes a parenting class. The credit al-**  
7 **lowed under this section may be claimed once by a taxpayer.**

8 **(2) The Department of Revenue, in consultation with the Department of Human Services,**  
9 **shall prescribe by rule criteria for substantiating completion and expenses of a parenting**  
10 **class.**

11 **(3) The amount of the credit allowed under subsection (1) of this section shall be the**  
12 **lesser of:**

13 **(a) The unreimbursed expenses of the taxpayer associated with attending class meetings,**  
14 **including enrollment fees, cost of printed materials, cost of transportation to the class**  
15 **meetings and child care fees necessitated by attendance; or**

16 **(b) \$400.**

17 **(4) A nonresident shall be allowed the credit under this section in the proportion provided**  
18 **under ORS 316.117.**

19 **(5) If a change in the tax year of a taxpayer occurs as described in ORS 314.085, or if the**  
20 **Department of Revenue terminates the taxpayer's tax year under ORS 314.440, the credit**  
21 **allowed under this section shall be prorated or computed in a manner consistent with ORS**  
22 **314.085.**

23 **(6) If a change in the status of a taxpayer from resident to nonresident or from nonres-**  
24 **ident to resident occurs, the credit allowed under this section shall be determined in a**  
25 **manner consistent with ORS 316.117.**

26 **SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2009 Act applies to tax years beginning on or after January**  
27 **1, 2010.**

28 **SECTION 4. This 2009 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the reg-**  
29 **ular session of the Seventy-fifth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
