A BILL FOR AN ACT Relating to home health services. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. The Department of Human Services shall study the regulation and licensure of providers of home health services as defined in ORS 443.005. SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2009 Act is repealed on January 2, 2012.
