House Bill 3349

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires that, if Department of Human Services provides funds to county for school-based health centers, department shall require county to allocate funds based on percentage of clients in county served by each center.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 2 Relating to school-based health centers. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. If the Department of Human Services provides funding to a county for school-based health centers, the department shall require the county to allocate the funds 5 to school-based health centers according to the percentage of the total number of clients 6 served by school-based health centers in the county that are served by each school-based health center. SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2009 Act applies to funding provided to a county for 9 10 school-based health centers on or after the effective date of this 2009 Act.
