

House Bill 3422

Sponsored by Representative KAHL; Representatives BERGER, DEMBROW, GALIZIO, SCHAUFLER, SHIELDS, WITT

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Transportation to make certain information concerning public contracts available on publicly accessible website.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to Department of Transportation public contracts.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Transportation shall make available by means of a**
5 **searchable and publicly accessible website the following information for each contract that**
6 **the department awards:**

7 (a) **The name of the contractor to which the department awarded the contract;**

8 (b) **The original amount of the contractor's bid;**

9 (c) **The final contract price after accounting for change orders, amendments or other**
10 **alterations to the scope of work under the contract, along with the cost of the change order,**
11 **amendment or alteration to the scope of work;**

12 (d) **Whether the department awarded the contract by competitive bid and the number of**
13 **bids the department received;**

14 (e) **Whether the department received a bid from and awarded the contract to a bidder**
15 **that was a minority or women business enterprise or an emerging small business, as those**
16 **terms are defined in ORS 200.005;**

17 (f) **The identification number for the contract;**

18 (g) **The names of the contractor's subcontractors;**

19 (h) **The original contract term, whether amendments extended the original term and the**
20 **date on which the amended contract term expires; and**

21 (i) **If the contract is a personal services contract, the cost the department incurred for**
22 **the contract and the cost the department would have incurred to perform the same services**
23 **using the department's own resources or personnel.**

24 (2) **The department shall ensure that the information described in subsection (1) of this**
25 **section is searchable by means of keywords, categories, subjects or other means intended to**
26 **enable a person to readily access the categories of information described in subsection (1)**
27 **of this section.**

28 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2009 Act applies to:**

29 (1) **Contracts that the Department of Transportation advertised or otherwise solicited**
30 **or entered into within a period that begins two calendar years before the effective date of**
31 **this 2009 Act and ends on the effective date of this 2009 Act; and**

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter *[italic and bracketed]* is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.

1 **(2) Contracts that the department first advertised or otherwise solicited or, if not ad-**
2 **vertised or solicited, first entered into on or after the effective date of this 2009 Act.**
