Shields person making report of child pornography found on electronic device from civil and criminal liability for report.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) A person who has reasonable cause to believe that a visual recording
5	stored on another person's electronic device depicts sexually explicit conduct involving a
6	child may not be held civilly or criminally liable for making a report of child pornography to
7	a law enforcement agency.
8	(2) As used in subsection (1) of this section, "sexually explicit conduct" has the meaning
9	given that term in ORS 163.665.
10	SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2009 Act applies to reports made on or after the effective
11	date of this 2009 Act.
