SUMMARY

Prohibits state government from employing individual who is not legal resident or does not have legal authorization to work.

Relating to legal presence.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. State government, as defined in ORS 174.111, may not employ an individual who is not a legal resident of the United States or who does not have legal authorization to work in the United States.
