## House Bill 3438

Sponsored by Representative WINGARD

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## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Permits person to operate motorcycle without motorcycle helmet if person has increased motor vehicle liability coverage for personal injury.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to motorcycles; amending ORS 806.070 and 814.290.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 814.290 is amended to read:
- 814.290. (1) [This section establishes exemptions from the requirements and penalties relating to the use of motorcycle helmets under ORS 814.260 to 814.280.] A person is not in violation of ORS 814.260,
- 7 [814.269,] 814.275 or 814.280 if the person is any of the following:
  - [(1)] (a) Within an enclosed cab.
  - [(2)] (b) Operating or riding a vehicle designed to travel with three wheels in contact with the ground at speeds of less than 15 miles per hour.
    - (2) A person is not in violation of ORS 814.269 if the person:
    - (a) Has a motor vehicle liability insurance policy that meets the requirements of ORS 806.070 (3);
      - (b) Is within an enclosed cab; or
  - (c) Is operating or riding a vehicle designed to travel with three wheels in contact with the ground at speeds of less than 15 miles per hour.
    - **SECTION 2.** ORS 806.070 is amended to read:
- 18 806.070. (1) This section establishes a schedule of payments for the following purposes:
  - (a) An insurance policy described under ORS 806.080 must provide for payment of at least amounts necessary to cover the minimum required payments under [this] subsection (2) of this section to qualify for use for financial responsibility under ORS 806.060.
  - (b) A person who is self-insured under ORS 806.130 must agree to pay according to the payment schedule established by [this section] subsection (2) of this section.
  - (c) A person who operates a motorcycle and who wants to qualify for the exemption from wearing a motorcycle helmet under ORS 814.290 must agree to pay according to the payment schedule established by subsection (3) of this section.
  - [(c)] (d) The payment schedule is the minimum required payment of a judgment for purposes of ORS 809.020, 809.130 and 809.415.
    - (2) The schedule of payments is as follows:
    - (a) \$25,000 because of bodily injury to or death of one person in any one accident;
    - (b) Subject to that limit for one person, \$50,000 because of bodily injury to or death of two or

1	more persons in any one accident; and
2	(c) \$10,000 because of injury to or destruction of the property of others in any one accident.
3	(3) For a person who operates a motorcycle and who wants to qualify for the exemption
4	from wearing a motorcycle helmet under ORS 814.290, the schedule of payments is as follows:
5	(a) \$1 million because of bodily injury to or death of one person in any one accident;
6	(b) Subject to that limit for one person, \$1.5 million because of bodily injury to or death
7	of two or more persons in any one accident; and
8	(c) \$10,000 because of injury to or destruction of the property of others in any one acci-
9	dent.

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
