## House Bill 3489

Sponsored by Representatives KRIEGER, ROBLAN

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Directs State Department of Fish and Wildlife to develop plan for reforming department-operated fish hatcheries on Oregon coast.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to fish hatcheries; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) The State Department of Fish and Wildlife shall develop a plan to reform
5	operation of department-operated fish hatcheries on the Oregon coast.
6	(2) The plan shall include provisions for the evaluation of current coastal hatchery pro-
7	grams with respect to:
8	(a) Broodstock and production management strategies;
9	(b) Hatchery infrastructure enhancement plans in support of management strategies;
10	(c) Hatchery effluent management and National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System
11	compliance recommendations;
12	(d) Recommended strategies for the management of fish disease; and
13	(e) Prioritization of deferred maintenance.
14	(3) The department shall complete the plan and submit the plan to an interim legislative
15	committee related to environment and natural resources for review on or before October 1,
16	2010.
17	SECTION 2. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
18	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect
19	on its passage.
