

# House Bill 3489

Sponsored by Representatives KRIEGER, ROBLAN

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs State Department of Fish and Wildlife to develop plan for reforming department-operated fish hatcheries on Oregon coast.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to fish hatcheries; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The State Department of Fish and Wildlife shall develop a plan to reform**  
5 **operation of department-operated fish hatcheries on the Oregon coast.**

6 **(2) The plan shall include provisions for the evaluation of current coastal hatchery pro-**  
7 **grams with respect to:**

8 **(a) Broodstock and production management strategies;**

9 **(b) Hatchery infrastructure enhancement plans in support of management strategies;**

10 **(c) Hatchery effluent management and National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System**  
11 **compliance recommendations;**

12 **(d) Recommended strategies for the management of fish disease; and**

13 **(e) Prioritization of deferred maintenance.**

14 **(3) The department shall complete the plan and submit the plan to an interim legislative**  
15 **committee related to environment and natural resources for review on or before October 1,**  
16 **2010.**

17 **SECTION 2. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
18 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect**  
19 **on its passage.**
