8	reduction in the term of incarceration for appropriate institutional behavior, as defined by rule of
9	the Department of Corrections, and for participation in the adult basic skills development program
10	described in ORS 421.084.
11	"(2)[(a)] The maximum amount of time credits earned for appropriate institutional behavior or
12	for participation in the adult basic skills development program described in ORS 421.084 may not
13	exceed [30] 20 percent of the total term of incarceration in a Department of Corrections institution.
14	"[(b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a) of this subsection, the maximum amount of time credits earned
15	under this section may not exceed 20 percent of the total term of incarceration in a Department of
16	Corrections institution if the sentence is for conviction of:]
17	"[(A) Rape in the third degree under ORS 163.355;]
18	"[(B) Sodomy in the third degree under ORS 163.385;]
19	"[(C) Sexual abuse in the second degree under ORS 163.425;]
20	"[(D) Criminally negligent homicide under ORS 163.145;]
21	"[(E) Assault in the third degree under ORS 163.165;]
22	"[(F) Assault in the fourth degree under ORS 163.160 (3);]
23	"[(G) A crime listed in ORS 137.700; or]
24	"[(H) An attempt to commit a crime described in subparagraphs (A) to (G) of this paragraph.]
25	"(3) The time credits may not be used to shorten the term of actual prison confinement to less
26	than six months.
27	"(4) The department shall adopt rules pursuant to the rulemaking provisions of ORS chapter 183
28	to establish a process for granting, retracting and restoring the time credits earned by the offender
29	as allowed in subsections (1) to (3) of this section.".
