Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$108,541,761 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for 2627payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of Cor-28rections for operations. "SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation 29 made to the Department of Corrections for administration, public services, general services 30 31 and human resources established by section 1 (2), chapter 594, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium ending June 30, 2009, is reduced by \$1,422,689. 32"SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation 33 34 made to the Department of Corrections for community corrections established by section 1 35(4), chapter 594, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium ending June 30, 2009, is increased by

1 **\$1,500,000.**

2 "<u>SECTION 6.</u> Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
3 made to the Department of Corrections for debt service established by section 1 (5), chapter
4 594, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium ending June 30, 2009, is reduced by \$77,311.

5 "<u>SECTION 7.</u> This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 6 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect 7 on its passage.".
