

# A-Engrossed House Bill 5006

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Directs distribution of moneys from Criminal Fine and Assessment Account.  
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2009.

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to financial administration of the Criminal Fine and Assessment Account; and declaring an  
3 emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5     **SECTION 1. Notwithstanding ORS 137.300, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, the**  
6 **Department of Revenue shall distribute the moneys in the Criminal Fine and Assessment**  
7 **Account, reduced by the amount reported by the Department of Justice to the Department**  
8 **of Revenue under ORS 137.300 (6) as specified in sections 3 to 5 of this 2009 Act.**

9     **SECTION 2. The allocation of the Criminal Fine and Assessment Account made by this**  
10 **2009 Act supersedes, replaces and is in lieu of any allocation of such funds in prior years.**

11     **SECTION 3. There are allocated to the Department of Public Safety Standards and**  
12 **Training for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, from the Criminal Fine and Assessment**  
13 **Account the following amounts for the following purposes:**

14       (1) **Police Standards and Training**  
15             **Accounts for criminal**  
16             **justice training and**  
17             **standards operations..... \$ 29,068,232**

18       (2) **Public Safety Memorial Fund**  
19             **established under ORS 243.950.. \$ 95,000**

20     **SECTION 4. There are allocated to the Department of Human Services for the biennium**  
21 **beginning July 1, 2009, from the Criminal Fine and Assessment Account the following**  
22 **amounts for the following purposes:**

23       (1) **Domestic Violence Fund**  
24             **for the purpose of**  
25             **ORS 409.292 (1)(a) to (c)..... \$ 2,224,675**

26       (2) **Sexual Assault Victims Fund.... \$ 533,332**

27       (3) **Emergency Medical Services and**  
28             **Trauma Systems Program created**

2 **SECTION 5.** There are allocated to the Department of Justice for the biennium beginning  
3 **July 1, 2009, from the Criminal Fine and Assessment Account the following amounts for the**  
4 **following purposes:**

5 (1) **Criminal Injuries Compensation**  
6 **Account..... \$ 8,153,823**

7 (2) **Services to children eligible for**  
8 **compensation under ORS 147.390**  
9 **and costs to administer provision of**  
10 **these services, which costs may not**  
11 **exceed five percent ..... \$ 724,608**

12 (3) **Child Abuse Multidisciplinary**  
13 **Intervention Account..... \$ 8,948,820**

14 (4) **Creation and operation of a statewide**  
15 **system of regional assessment centers**  
16 **as provided under ORS 418.746 to**  
17 **418.796 ..... \$ 857,215**

18 **SECTION 6.** After distributing the amounts specified in sections 3 to 5 of this 2009 Act,  
19 **the Department of Revenue shall distribute funds remaining in the Criminal Fine and As-**  
20 **essment Account to the General Fund.**

21 **SECTION 7.** This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
22 **peace, health and safety, and emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect**  
23 **July 1, 2009.**
