## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Emergency Board for allocations during biennium. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration of the Emergency Board; appropriating money; and de-3 claring an emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-6 ated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out of the General 7 Fund, the amount of \$30,000,000 for the purposes for which the Emergency Board lawfully

8 may allocate funds.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out of the General
 Fund, the amount of \$5,100,000, to be allocated to state agencies for state employee compensation changes for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009.

(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this section are not allocated
by the Emergency Board prior to December 1, 2010, the moneys remaining on that date become available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.
<u>SECTION 3.</u> (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out of the General
Fund, the amount of \$5,119,084, to be allocated to the State Forestry Department to pay for
fire insurance premium costs and severity resources.

(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this section are not allocated
 by the Emergency Board prior to December 1, 2010, the moneys remaining on that date be come available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.

23 <u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 24 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect 25 on its passage.
