SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Employment Department for biennial expenses. Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and federal funds from Reed Act, but excluding lottery funds and other federal funds collected or received by department.

Appropriates moneys from certain federal funds to department for certain purposes.

Appropriates moneys from Employment Department Special Administrative Fund for certain purposes.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds other than federal funds from Reed Act.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2009.

1 A BILL FOR AN ACT

- Relating to financial administration of the Employment Department; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - <u>SECTION 1.</u> There is appropriated to the Employment Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$3,420,698.
 - SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and moneys appropriated to the Employment Department by section 3 of this 2009 Act, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds other than those described in section 3 of this 2009 Act, collected or received by the Employment Department:
- 13 (1) Operating budget \$130,441,244
 - (2) Debt service \$ 378,700
- 15 (3) Capital Improvement \$ 125,600
 - SECTION 3. There is appropriated to the Employment Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out of the funds made available to this state on March 13, 2002, under section 903(d) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1103(d)), as amended, the amount of \$24,700,000 to be used under the direction of the Employment Department for the purposes of administering unemployment compensation law and public employment offices.
- SECTION 4. There is appropriated to the Employment Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out of the Employment Department Special Administrative Fund

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created by ORS 657.822, the amount of \$9,500,000 to be used under the direction of the Em
ployment Department for the purposes of administering unemployment compensation law
and public employment offices.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$282,471,173 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 3 of this 2009 Act collected or received by the Employment Department.

<u>SECTION 6.</u> (1) For the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, expenditures by the Employment Department for unemployment insurance claims from the Unemployment Compensation Trust Fund are not limited.

(2) For the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, expenditures by the Employment Department for purposes of carrying out the federal Trade Act and for unemployment insurance claims from federal funds are not limited.

<u>SECTION 7.</u> This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect July 1, 2009.
