SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Employment Relations Board for biennial expenses. Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds and certain other funds, collected or received by board.

Limits biennial expenditures by board from moneys received from assessment against state agencies.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2009.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to financial administration of the Employment Relations Board; appropriating money; lim-

3 iting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> There is appropriated to the Employment Relations Board, for the biennium 6 beginning July 1, 2009, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,858,241.

7 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$268,890 8 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for payment of 9 expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-10 cluding lottery funds, federal funds and funds described in section 3 of this 2009 Act, collected 11 or received by the Employment Relations Board.

12 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 13 \$1,569,838 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for 14 payment of expenses from moneys received from the assessment against state agencies de-15 scribed in ORS 240.167 and transferred to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services 16 Operating Fund for the Employment Relations Board.

17 <u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 18 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect 19 July 1, 2009.
