

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5025

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 27.

2 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 44 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Legislative Administration Committee, for**
4 **the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for**
5 **payment of the expenses of the Legislative Administration Committee for the following pur-**
6 **poses:**

7 (1) General program..... \$ 19,708,894

8 (2) Debt service \$ 5,766,596

9 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
10 **\$4,575,874 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for**
11 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**
12 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Ad-**
13 **ministration Committee.**

14 **“SECTION 3. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, expenditures by the Legislative**
15 **Administration Committee from the Stores Revolving Account and the Property and Supplies**
16 **Stores Account established by ORS 173.790 are not limited.**

17 **“SECTION 4. There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium begin-**
18 **ning July 1, 2009, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$10,258,085 for payment of the ex-**
19 **penses of the following offices:**

20 **“(1) The offices of the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Repre-**
21 **sentatives;**

22 **“(2) The majority and minority offices of the Senate and of the House of Representatives;**
23 **and**

24 **“(3) The offices of the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of Rep-**
25 **resentatives.**

26 **“SECTION 5. (1) There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium**
27 **beginning July 1, 2009, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$15,449,172 for payment of the**
28 **expenses of members of the Seventy-fifth Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.**

29 **“(2) There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium beginning July**
30 **1, 2009, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$7,226,709 for payment of the expenses of**
31 **members of the Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.**

32 **“SECTION 6. Notwithstanding ORS 293.190, any moneys remaining from the appropri-**
33 **ations made by sections 4 and 5 (2), chapter 762, Oregon Laws 2007, on June 30, 2009, are**
34 **transferred to the Emergency Board on July 1, 2009, to be available for any purpose for**
35 **which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.**

1 **“SECTION 7.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
2 \$208,653 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for
3 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,
4 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative As-
5 sembly of the State of Oregon.

6 **“SECTION 8.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, expenditures by the Legislative
7 Assembly from the Lounge Revolving Account established by ORS 171.117 for the costs of
8 food served in members’ lounges and reimbursed through receipts on the basis of sales or
9 by payroll deductions from members are not limited.

10 **“SECTION 9.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Counsel Committee, for the
11 biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$8,413,056.

12 **“SECTION 10.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
13 \$121,966 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for
14 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,
15 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Counsel
16 Committee from state agencies or other offices for bill drafting and any other legal services
17 authorized or required by law to be rendered by the Legislative Counsel Committee, including
18 duties under ORS 183.710 to 183.725 provided pursuant to policies established by the Legisla-
19 tive Counsel Committee.

20 **“SECTION 11.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
21 \$1,391,651 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for
22 payment of expenses by the Legislative Counsel Committee from the ORS Revolving Account
23 established by ORS 171.305 for personnel costs connected with the editing of the Oregon Re-
24 vised Statutes.

25 **“SECTION 12.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, expenditures by the Legislative
26 Counsel Committee from the ORS Revolving Account established by ORS 171.305 and from
27 the Legislative Publications Account established by ORS 171.245, for services and supplies
28 connected with printing and distributing legislative publications and the Oregon Revised
29 Statutes, are not limited.

30 **“SECTION 13.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Fiscal Officer, for the biennium
31 beginning July 1, 2009, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$6,000,198.

32 **“SECTION 14.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Revenue Officer, for the biennium
33 beginning July 1, 2009, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$2,147,121.

34 **“SECTION 15.** There is appropriated to the Commission on Indian Services, for the
35 biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$414,701.

36 **“SECTION 16.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$6,280
37 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for payment of
38 expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
39 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Commission on Indian
40 Services.

41 **“SECTION 17.** This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
42 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect
43 July 1, 2009.”
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
