SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Youth Authority for certain biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Re-ceipts and federal funds received from Department of Education and Department of Human Services for nutrition programs and alcohol and drug abuse prevention programs, but excluding lottery funds and other federal funds, collected or received by Oregon Youth Authority for certain purposes. Limits biennial expenditures by Oregon Youth Authority from federal funds.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2009.

4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Oregon Youth Authority, for the biennium
6	beginning July 1, 2009, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the following
7	purposes:
8	(1) Operations \$251,090,727
9	(2) Debt service \$ 7,653,121
10	(3) Capital improvements \$ 735,400
11	SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
12	\$14,810,721 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for
13	payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts
14	and federal funds received from the Department of Education and the Department of Human
15	Services for nutrition programs and alcohol and drug abuse prevention programs, but ex-
16	cluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in this section, collected or received
17	by the Oregon Youth Authority.
18	SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
19	\$31,446,577 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for
20	payment of expenses from federal funds, other than those described in section 2 of this 2009
21	Act, collected or received by the Oregon Youth Authority.
22	SECTION 4. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect 2324 July 1, 2009.
