7	\$400,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for
8	payment of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 4, chapter 698,
9	Oregon Laws 2007, collected or received by the Department of Community Colleges and
10	Workforce Development for the Oregon Youth Conservation Corps.
11	(2) For the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, expenditures by the Employment Department
12	from federal funds received by the Employment Department pursuant to the American Re-
13	covery and Reinvestment Act, P.L. 111-5, for unemployment insurance claims are not limited.
14	SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative
15	Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the office of the Governor estab-
16	lished by section 22, chapter 745, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007,
17	is decreased by \$13,722.
18	SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative
19	Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Economic and Community De-
20	velopment Department for department operations established by section 3 (1), chapter 745,
21	Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, is decreased by \$70,979.
22	SECTION 8. Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative
23	Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Problem Gambling Treatment
24	Fund established by section 11, chapter 745, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning
25	July 1, 2007, is decreased by \$1,994.
26	SECTION 9. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
27	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect

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on its passage.

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
