

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5053

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, delete “limiting expenditures;”.

2 Delete lines 5 through 18 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appro-**
4 **priation made to the Department of State Police by section 1 (1), chapter __, Oregon Laws**
5 **2009 (Enrolled House Bill 5037), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is increased by**
6 **\$6,715,016 for patrol services, criminal investigations and gaming enforcement.**

7 **“(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation made**
8 **to the Department of State Police by section 1 (2), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled**
9 **House Bill 5037), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is increased by \$913,280 for fish and**
10 **wildlife enforcement.**

11 **“(3) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation made**
12 **to the Department of State Police by section 1 (3), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled**
13 **House Bill 5037), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is increased by \$4,523,282 for**
14 **forensic services and the State Medical Examiner.**

15 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation**
16 **made to the Oregon Youth Authority by section 1 (1), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2009 (En-**
17 **rolled House Bill 5051), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is increased by \$23,612,265 for**
18 **operations.**

19 **“SECTION 3. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appro-**
20 **priation made to the Department of Corrections by section 1 (1), chapter __, Oregon Laws**
21 **2009 (Enrolled House Bill 5005), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is increased by**
22 **\$8,200,792 for operations.**

23 **“(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation made**
24 **to the Department of Corrections by section 1 (2), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled**
25 **House Bill 5005), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is increased by \$1,000,000 for ad-**
26 **ministration, public services, general services and human resources.**

27 **“(3) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation made**
28 **to the Department of Corrections by section 1 (3), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled**
29 **House Bill 5005), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is increased by \$1,886,767 for tran-**
30 **sitional services.**

31 **“(4) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation made**
32 **to the Department of Corrections by section 1 (4), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled**
33 **House Bill 5005), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is increased by \$6,070,757 for com-**
34 **munity corrections.**

35 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation**

1 made to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission by section 1, chapter __, Oregon Laws
2 2009 (Enrolled House Bill 5007), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is increased by
3 \$1,553,207.

4 “SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
5 made to the Department of Justice by section 1, chapter __, Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled
6 House Bill 5022), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is increased by \$2,971,639.

7 “SECTION 6. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
8 priated to the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training, for the biennium begin-
9 ning July 1, 2009, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,056,000 for operations.

10 “SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
11 made to the Department of Justice by section 1, chapter __, Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled
12 Senate Bill 5518), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is increased by \$456,835 for paying
13 expenses of district attorneys.

14 “SECTION 8. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
15 made to the Public Defense Services Commission by section 1 (2), chapter __, Oregon Laws
16 2009 (Enrolled House Bill 5040), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is increased by
17 \$1,105,814 for the Public Defense Services Account.

18 “SECTION 9. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
19 priated to the Judicial Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out of the Gen-
20 eral Fund, the amount of \$131,064 for operations.

21 “SECTION 10. Sections 1 to 9 of this 2009 Act become operative only if House Bill 3508
22 becomes law. Sections 1 to 9 of this 2009 Act become operative on the date House Bill 3508
23 becomes law.

24 “SECTION 11. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
25 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect
26 July 1, 2009.”.

27
