HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5054

"SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$30,000,000 for the purposes for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.

"SECTION 2. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$32,000,000 for supplemental allocations to state agencies for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009.

"(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this section are not allocated by the Emergency Board prior to July 1, 2010, the moneys remaining on that date become available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.

"SECTION 3. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,500,000 to be allocated to the Department of Justice for ongoing legal costs of the defense of the revenue stream from the Master Settlement Agreement with tobacco companies.

"(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this section are not allocated by the Emergency Board prior to December 1, 2010, the moneys remaining on that date become available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.

"SECTION 4. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$5,971,896 for debt service on projects funded with certificates of participation sold under chapter 2, Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled Senate Bill 338).

"(2) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$537,338 for debt service on the Mill Creek Infrastructure project.

"SECTION 5.
