

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5055

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, delete “limiting expenditures;”.

2 Delete lines 5 through 18 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation**
4 **made to the Oregon Youth Authority by section 1 (1), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2009 (En-**
5 **rolled House Bill 5051), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is increased by \$9,826,321 for**
6 **operations.**

7 **“SECTION 2. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appro-**
8 **priation made to the Department of Corrections by section 1 (1), chapter __, Oregon Laws**
9 **2009 (Enrolled House Bill 5005), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is decreased by**
10 **\$12,218,265 for operations and health services.**

11 **“(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation made**
12 **to the Department of Corrections by section 1 (2), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled**
13 **House Bill 5005), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$3,144,002 for ad-**
14 **ministration, public services, general services and human resources.**

15 **“(3) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation made**
16 **to the Department of Corrections by section 1 (3), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled**
17 **House Bill 5005), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$9,459,060 for tran-**
18 **sitional services.**

19 **“(4) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation made**
20 **to the Department of Corrections by section 1 (4), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled**
21 **House Bill 5005), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is increased by \$6,550,608 for com-**
22 **munity corrections.**

23 **“(5) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation made**
24 **to the Department of Corrections by section 1 (6), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled**
25 **House Bill 5005), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$400,000 for capital**
26 **improvements.**

27 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation**
28 **made to the Department of Justice by section 1, chapter __, Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled**
29 **Senate Bill 5518), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is increased by \$38,000 for paying**
30 **expenses of district attorneys.**

31 **“SECTION 4. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appro-**
32 **priation made to the Department of State Police by section 1 (1), chapter __, Oregon Laws**
33 **2009 (Enrolled House Bill 5037), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is decreased by**
34 **\$2,210,109 for patrol services, criminal investigations and gaming enforcement.**

35 **“(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation made**

1 to the Department of State Police by section 1 (2), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled
2 House Bill 5037), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is increased by \$913,280 for fish and
3 wildlife enforcement.

4 “(3) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation made
5 to the Department of State Police by section 1 (3), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled
6 House Bill 5037), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is increased by \$4,478,922 for
7 forensic services and the State Medical Examiner.

8 “SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
9 made to the Public Defense Services Commission by section 1 (2), chapter __, Oregon Laws
10 2009 (Enrolled House Bill 5040), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is increased by
11 \$74,000 for the Public Defense Services Account.

12 “SECTION 6. Sections 1 to 5 of this 2009 Act become operative only if House Bill 3508
13 becomes law. Sections 1 to 5 of this 2009 Act become operative on the date House Bill 3508
14 becomes law.

15 “SECTION 7. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
16 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect
17 July 1, 2009.”
