JOINT MEMORIAL

Urges Congress to enact legislation increasing veterans' access to health care.

| 8 | Whereas this discrepancy leaves more than \$4 billion in potential benefits unclaimed; and |
| 9 | Whereas many veterans who are not enrolled in the Veterans Health Administration live in |
| 10 | rural areas; and |
| 11 | Whereas the Governor's Task Force on Veterans' Services Final Report stated that equity in |
| 12 | access is an issue for veterans who live in rural areas; and |
| 13 | Whereas geographic distance creates barriers for veterans' access to adequate health care; now |
| 14 | therefore, |
| 15 | Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon: |
| 16 | (1) The Seventy-fifth Legislative Assembly urges the Congress of the United States to enac |
| 17 | legislation that: |
| 18 | (a) Adds a proportional differential to the formula-based health services to increase access for |
| 19 | veterans who live in rural areas. |
| 20 | (b) Requires the Veterans Health Administration to work with national, regional and state |
| 21 | leaders representing rural areas to establish a formula that increases access and decreases trans |
| 22 | portation costs for veterans seeking health care. |
