2	To the President of the United States and the Senate and the House of Representatives of the United
3	States of America, in Congress assembled:
4	We, your memorialists, the Seventy-fifth Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon, in legis-
5	lative session assembled, respectfully represent as follows:
6	Whereas the State of Oregon spends millions of dollars annually to incarcerate illegal aliens
7	who have committed crimes in this state; and
8	Whereas the defense of our borders and the prevention of illegal immigration is a matter of
9	federal importance and concern; now, therefore,
10	Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:
11	That we, the members of the Seventy-fifth Legislative Assembly, respectfully request that the
12	Congress of the United States authorize and appropriate funding to fully reimburse Oregon taxpay-
13	ers for the cost of incarcerating illegal immigrants who have committed crimes in this state; and
14	be it further
15	Resolved, That a copy of this memorial shall be sent to the President of the United States and
16	to each member of the Oregon Congressional Delegation.
