House Joint Resolution 48

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON REVENUE

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution allowing Legislative Assembly to impose taxes on carbon emissions for purpose of funding reductions in carbon emissions and carbon fuel use. Refers proposed amendment to people for their approval or rejection at next regular general election.

1	JOINT RESOLUTION
2	Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:
3	PARAGRAPH 1. The Constitution of the State of Oregon is amended by creating a new section
4	15 to be added to and made a part of Article IX, such section to read:
5	SECTION 15. (1) The Legislative Assembly may impose taxes on the release of carbon
6	emissions into air or water or onto land.
7	(2) Revenues received under taxes imposed pursuant to subsection (1) of this section shall
8	be used for funding:
9	(a) Construction or installation of alternative energy systems that do not release carbon
10	emissions into air or water or onto land; and
11	(b) Implementation of systems or programs that result in the reduction of the use of
12	carbon fuels.
13	(3) The Legislative Assembly may enact laws providing for the administration and col-
14	lection of taxes imposed pursuant to subsection (1) of this section.
15	
16	PARAGRAPH 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be submitted to the
17	people for their approval or rejection at the next regular general election held throughout
18	this state.
