Encourages school districts to provide character education programs.

8	Whereas several school districts across this state have successfully implemented character ed
9	ucation programs that may be used as models for other school districts to develop character edu
10	cation programs; now, therefore,
11	Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:
12	That we, the members of the Seventy-fifth Legislative Assembly, encourage school districts to
13	provide character education programs.
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
