CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to Department of Corrections.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) **Beginning in 2012, and every six years thereafter, the Department of Corrections shall conduct a study to determine the actual costs incurred by each county of providing management, support services, supervision and sanctions for offenders described in ORS 423.478 (2).**

(2) **The department may adopt rules to carry out the provisions of this section.**
