

**SENATE AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 106**

1 Delete lines 9 and 10 of the printed bill and insert:

2 “(2)(a) Except as provided in paragraph (b) of this subsection, the Oregon Youth Authority may
3 receive applications from, and award funds under a competitive process to, tribes for the adminis-
4 tration and provision of services to tribal youth. The services eligible for funding under this sub-
5 section must be intended to protect the public and reduce juvenile delinquency.

6 “(b) Tribes are not eligible for diversion funds under ORS 420.017.

7 “(c) As used in this subsection, ‘tribal youth’ means a member of a tribe who is:

8 “(A) A youth as defined in ORS 419A.004; or

9 “(B) A person under 18 years of age who:

10 “(i) Has more than one of the risk factors identified in ORS 417.855 (2)(a); or

11 “(ii) Is demonstrating at-risk behaviors that will lead to imminent or increased involvement in
12 the juvenile justice system.”.
