

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 127

By COMMITTEE ON BUSINESS AND TRANSPORTATION

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, delete lines 36 through 45 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 5.** ORS 806.200 is amended to read:

3 “806.200. (1) A person commits the offense of failure to make a future responsibility filing after  
4 an accident if *[the person is the owner or driver of a vehicle that is in any manner involved in an*  
5 *accident that is required to be reported under ORS 811.720 and the person does not make a future re-*  
6 *responsibility filing within 30 days after the filing of the accident report required under ORS 811.725.]*:

7 “(a) **The person is the owner or driver of a motor vehicle involved in an accident;**

8 “(b) **At the time of the accident the vehicle was operated in violation of ORS 806.010;**

9 “(c) **The person does not make a future responsibility filing within 30 days after the ac-**  
10 **cident; and**

11 “(d) **The person is not exempt under ORS 806.210 from making a future responsibility**  
12 **filing.**

13 “[*(2) Exemptions from this section are established under ORS 806.210.*]

14 “[*(3) (2) The employer of a driver is subject to the requirements and penalties under this sec-*  
15 *tion if the driver is an employee exempted from this section under ORS 806.210. If an employer is*  
16 *subject to this section, the registration of the employer’s vehicles may be suspended as provided*  
17 *under ORS 809.050.*]

18 “[*(4) (3) In addition to any other penalties under this section, violation of this section subjects*  
19 *the violator to suspension of driving privileges as provided under ORS 809.415.*]

20 “[*(5) (4) The offense described in this section, failure to make a future responsibility filing after*  
21 *an accident, is a Class B traffic violation.*”.

22 On page 3, delete lines 1 through 8.

23 On page 5, line 12, before the period insert “or a risk retention group as defined in ORS  
24 735.305”.
