SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Creates Task Force on Long-Range Capital Planning. Requires task force to study methods state agencies use to measure and report facility construction and maintenance needs and to review actions other states and organizations take to assess long-range construction needs and identify deferred maintenance problems.]

[Sunsets task force on date of convening of next regular biennial legislative session.]

Allows Department of Corrections to lease real property located in Lane County and improvements to that property to Department of Human Services. Allows Department of Human Services to build, own and operate hospital for certain committed individuals on that property. Allows Department of Human Services to transfer ownership of hospital to Department of Corrections.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to public facility planning; creating new provisions; amending ORS 426.010; and declaring
3 an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** (1) **Notwithstanding ORS 421.611 to 421.630 or any actions taken under ORS**
6 **421.611 to 421.630, the Department of Corrections may lease all or part of the real property**
7 **and any improvements to the real property known as the Milliron Road Site south of Junc-**
8 **tion City, Lane County, to the Department of Human Services for a period of years agreed**
9 **upon by the Department of Corrections and the Department of Human Services.**

10 (2) **The Department of Human Services may build, own and operate, on the real property**
11 **leased from the Department of Corrections under subsection (1) of this section, a hospital**
12 **to provide diagnosis and evaluation, medical care, detoxification, social services, rehabili-**
13 **tation or other services for individuals committed to the Department of Human Services**
14 **under ORS 426.130 and individuals committed to a state hospital under ORS 161.327 or**
15 **161.370.**

16 (3) **The Department of Corrections and the Department of Human Services are author-**
17 **ized to negotiate and enter into a written agreement transferring ownership of the hospital**
18 **described in subsection (2) of this section from the Department of Human Services to the**
19 **Department of Corrections, under terms and conditions acceptable to the agencies.**

20 **SECTION 2.** ORS 426.010 is amended to read:

21 426.010. Except as otherwise ordered by the Department of Human Services pursuant to ORS
22 179.325, the Oregon State Hospital [*in Salem, Marion County,*] **campuses in Salem, Marion County,**

1 **and in Junction City, Lane County,** and the Blue Mountain Recovery Center in Pendleton,
2 Umatilla County, shall be used as state hospitals for the care and treatment of mentally ill persons
3 who are assigned to the care of such institutions by the department or who have previously been
4 committed to such institutions.

5 **SECTION 3. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
6 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect**
7 **on its passage.**

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
